SABBATH JANUARY 01, 2022

Bible Texts: 2 Chronicles 7:13-15, Hebrews 12: 5-10, Matthew 7: 3-5, Ezekiel 9: 4-6, Hosea 4: 2-3

God's judgement begins with his own people. As children of God we are His ambassadors to a lost world

Group Discussion Questions:

- 1. Is it possible to influence people to live godly lives if we are not living out the example of Christ before them?
- 2. What effect does sin have on our lives?
- 3. What would happen if God does not punish sin or withhold His blessings?
- 4. What is God's purpose for us in this world? What spiritual gifts or talents has God given you?

Personal Reflection: What is painted on the walls of your mind? What particular sins keep the blessing of God from your church? Are you living as a child of God? Remember God sees the secret passion of our hearts and mind.

Prayer Focus: Thank the Lord that He is a Holy God and for His perfect and righteous ways Ask God to:

- Reveal any sins that hinder His blessing in you and through you to the household of faith.
- Help you to gain a better understanding of the role He has for you in bringing His blessings to the church.
- Forgive us as believers for blaming others for the condition of this church.
- Move in our midst to bring a deeper awareness of our responsibility to be His instruments in caring for this world.

SUNDAY JANUARY 02 2022

Bible Texts: 2 Chronicles 7:13-15, 1 Peter 2:9, 1 Corinthians 6:19-20, 2 Corinthians 6:18, Rev. 3:12

Group Discussion Questions:

- 1. What does it mean to be called by God's name? What obligations do we have now that God has called us to be His children and given us His name?
- 2. What difference should there be in our lives now that we belong to God?
- 3. How can spiritual gifts be used to release God's blessing to others?
- 4. What is the result when believers do not take seriously the fact that they are called by God's name?

Personal Reflection: Have you been using your spiritual gifts for the Lord? Have you been faithful to what God has called you to do? What encouragement do you find in the fact that God continues to work in you, transforming you more and more into His image?

Prayer Focus: Thank God that He does have a purpose for us and that He willingly made us His children. Ask God to:

- Show us our role in His kingdom
- Help us to be more willing to learn the lessons He wants to teach us.
- Open our hearts more fully to Him so that we can become all He wants us to become

MONDAY JANUARY 03, 2022

Bible Texts: 2 Chron. 7: 13-15, 2 Chron. 33: 22-23; Isaiah 58: 4-7, Ezra 8: 21, Psalm 25:9, Luke 18: 14

God requires prayer of confession, a cry for help and for compassion and mercy.

Group Discussion Questions:

- 1. What is the connection between humility and prayer in 2 Chronicles 7:14?
- 2. How is the prayer of the Pharisee in Luke 18:10-14 different from the prayer of the tax collector?
- 3. How do our prayers and our lifestyle reflect that we are trusting in God's enabling and leading?
- 4. What do we learn in 2 Chronicles 7 about the compassion of God toward those who humble themselves and come to Him?

Personal Reflection: Are you a humble person? Do you easily admit when you are wrong? Have you made a conscious decision to listen and wait on the Lord? Have you ever been guilty of praying the prayer of the Pharisee?

Prayer Focus: Take a moment to confess your failures and sins to God (silently) & ask the Lord to:

- Help us to see our guilt and need of Him in a greater way.
- Forgive us for our blindness to the needs of others
- Restore us to a deeper fellowship with Him
- Give us deeper faith and confidence in His purpose for our lives.

TUESDAY JANUARY 04, 2022

Bible Texts: 2 Chron. 7: 13-15, Exodus 33:18-20, Deut. 32:20; 31: 17-18, Rev.3:20, Psalm 119:57-59

We cannot seek God's face and seek other things at the same time. We must recognize our needs and commit ourselves to listening to God alone, then can we be truly blessed.

Group Discussion Questions:

- 1. Is seeking the Lord's face simply a matter of letting the Lord bless us? What happens when the Lord shines His face upon us?
- 2. What needs to be the commitment of those who seek the face of the Lord?
- 3. What is the connection between turning from our wicked ways and seeking the face of the Lord?
- 4. Does the sin in our individual lives have a direct impact on our church and our community?

Personal reflection: Do you allow the Lord to lead you in every aspect of your life? Identify the barriers of sin that is preventing God's face to shine on your life. What particular work has the Lord God been doing in your life recently?

Prayer Focus: Thank the Lord that He wants to reveal Himself to us in a deeper way. Ask the Lord to:

- * Expose the things in our life that we need to address in order for His face to shine more fully on us
- Make us more willing to see sin as He sees it.
- Lead us into the way He wants us to go.
- Allow us to experience the fullness of His blessing as we live in obedience.
